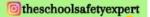

Introduction

In my years of experience as the CEO of a multi-unit organization while also working as a consultant/assessor in different organizations over the years, there are so many mistakes we have made as a business. Some caused reversible damages while others -sadly, caused much more harm than we could handle.

As someone who has been doing business for decades, sometimes I look back and wonder how we survived considering how many mistakes we made. Trust me, we made many.

Over the years, I have seen many businesses make these same mistakes due to lack of adequate information on how to avoid them.

In this short piece, I will be sharing ten common major mistakes most businesses make and how to avoid or deal with them.

Kick back, relax, and learn as much as you can from my wealth of knowledge.



MISTAKE ONE

BASING KEY DECISIONS ON SENTIMENTS.

ne of the biggest and perhaps most destructive mistakes most businesses make -especially in the start-up phase, is making important decisions based on sentiments.

The reason for its destructive nature is because a business is only as strong as the key decisions it makes.

One wrong decision can ruin your business; one right decision can transform your business.

Which is why when you make vital decisions about your business, they should be intelligent, calculated, and free



from sentiments.

An example of such decisions is your choice of staff.

When it comes to employing or managing your staff team, to ensure you run an efficient structured system, it is vital to start with those who are suitably qualified as opposed to 'pity recruiting'. Pity recruiting is a situation where we choose to 'help' someone who is especially not right for the job out of pity for them.

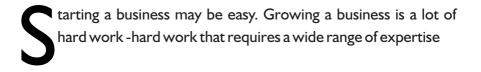
The same goes for relationships with your clients/customers. Basing decisions on how you work with them (e.g. postponing the payment of fees with clients you're not too familiar with) should be done more objectively and less on sentiments which tend to backfire in the end!

I remember we employed quite a number of our staff based on sentiments at initial start-up which almost cost us the





RUNNING A BUSINESS WITHOUT BUILDING SOME LEVEL OF EXPERTISE



Many businesses start without proper knowledge on many business concepts. While this may not be completely wrong as you can't wait to have complete knowledge before starting your business, it is important to make conscious efforts to garner knowledge and build expertise as you grow.

Start small. But as you grow, build the relevant skills you need to sustain that business.

Developing key skills such as understanding finances, people management, business model options, marketing, etc. is vital to help



you stay above board as a business owner/leader.

For us, we started our services with an After-school club then moved to our larger office to run the consultancy firm with a sales section and Training unit within a short period. We also started our nursery section a few years after.

Solution/What we did: Over the years, we have built greater capacity through constant professional development, partnerships and mentoring. Having the right mentors and coaches in business no matter how long you have been in existence helps to keep you accountable and growing. We have worked with partners and consultants in areas we are deficient too.

What you can do: Identify key issues you have in your business, find ways to solve them by choosing relevant books to read, mentors, courses, business study groups you can join, training programs, etc. Give yourself quarterly or timed targets to work on these areas, so they don't fester and cause your business to struggle or fail. Increase your capacity!



M

oney is the lifeblood of running a business, so when it is not managed suitably many issues can arise.

In our first 4 years of running the business, we did not have proper documentation or records. We also made the terrible decision of mixing money from the organization with personal funds.

We had no idea about financial planning, budgeting or accounting when we started our business at first. We were just 'winging it' most times.

It isn't surprising that many businesses make this mistake of mismanaging funds and having terrible record keeping habits. Many times, they just don't know better.



Solution/what we did: A few years into the business, we started the tedious, but rewarding process of gathering records from scratch. We worked with an accounting firm to also create means for internal control and better use of income. All units within the organization plan projects or work tasks based on weekly/monthly budgets as required. We have developed vouchers for payment, collected receipts for all office-related expenditures, improved our bookkeeping and also our payment approval process.

What you can do: What about you? Are your financial records intact? Are your records well filed, recorded or documented? Taxes up to date?

If they aren't, you should work with an accounting firm to get your accounts in order, and also a financial expert to help you manage your funds better.
